UC San Diego Conference Services offers a “per person, per night” rate beginning with guest arrival and check-in through guest check-out.

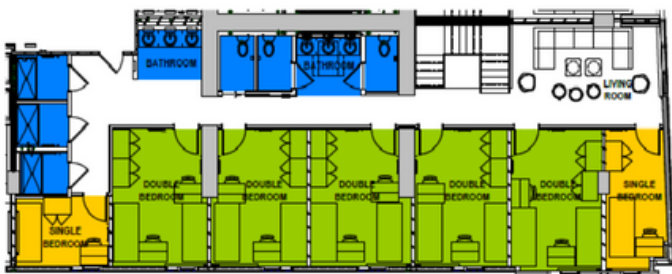
ACCOMMODATIONS & AMENITIES

Campus Housing is available to conference guests during the summer months and is assigned depending on conference needs. Choose from all-inclusive upscale apartment suites to more economical shared residential hall rooms.

Residence Halls

- Residence halls offer suites of different sizes with shared washrooms and living areas.
 - Standard suites are configured with four to six bedrooms that sleep one to two people per suite.
 - Mega suites are configured with seven to eight bedroom that sleep one to two people per suite and have a connecting staircase within the unit.

- Apartments are configured with three to four bedrooms that sleep one to two people per apartment with living room, kitchenette, and shared washrooms

Singles vs Doubles

- Single bedroom units offer one bed, desk space, dresser or closet, and one set of linen.
- Double bedroom units offer two bed, teodesk spaces , dresser or shaired closet, and two sets of linen.
- Both bedroom types have shared bathrooms and lounge spaces within the apartment or residence hall.

Mega Suites

- Mega suite units are perfect for large groups with the largest capacity accomodating 32 people between two shared floors.
- Mega suites offer both single and double units with shared bathrooms, 2 lounge spaces, and have a staircase within the units that connect top and bottom floors.

Shared Kitchens

- Resident halls do not have kitchens within the units, however there is a shared kitchen and lounge space on these floors that are available for communal use.
- Shared kitchen's are equipped with a full size refrigerator, oven, electric stovetop, microwave, a sink, and a shared pantry.
